The Half Hollow Hills Library has continually endeavored to be an integral partner of the School District's educational community. In addition, the library's program for SEPTA is a valuable service for the students of our School District.

On October 3, 2017, the Half Hollow Hills Community will be voting on a proposed bond referendum. The proposed new library will have expanded space for the children's room, a much needed increase in space for our pre-teen and High School students, more quiet study rooms, a Makerspace, a dedicated auditorium and stage, enhanced Wi-Fi and computer capabilities, increased community meeting rooms and so much more.
